2. What kind of attitude should a follower of Jesus have according to the following verses?
 - a) Matthew 20:28
 - b) Luke 17:7-10
 - c) Luke 18:9-14
3. Why do you think it is difficult to authentically have these attitudes? What makes it possible? How does Jesus' example encourage/challenge you? (see Luke 22:27; John 13:13-16; Phil 2:7)
4. Describe the difference between a volunteer and servant. How could you grow as a servant?
5. We have discovered our spiritual gifts, our calling as children of God, our purpose in the workplace, and how our story “unleashes” us to make God known in our church and community.
